MAIL'S IN!

In this photo you can see the 41 pounds of student mail from Malawi that we received at the WBS office in Cedar Park TX on October 6th. This mail was brought to us by Ron Pottberg, who recently returned from a WBS trip to Malawi. So far in 2016, we've received more Malawi mail (266 pounds) and enrolled more Malawi postal students (110,000) than in all of 2015 or 2014! This is great news, since in past years we've seen many times when student mail from Malawi stopped coming for months at a time, often due to severe economic problems within the country. Please pray that this positive trend continues, and that many more souls will hear the Gospel through WBS lessons shared by encouraging WBS study helpers. (As I write this, we're also expecting 26 pounds of student mail from Zimbabwe very soon.)



WBS CUSTOM PRINTED BIBLE ON THE WAY!

As we reported in August, we're getting closer to producing a WBS custom-printed Bible. The Bible will be the English Standard Version and is titled *The Bible, World Bible School Study Edition*, and is of excellent quality. *It will include 112 pages for a Topical Index and Guide to New Testament Christianity as supplementary materials.* These enhancements maintain the strong standards of WBS Bible study that are integral to the Master Series. We have placed the order with the printer, and expect the initial print run to be delivered to us here in Cedar Park late this year, with Bibles ready for sale early in 2017. Watch for more details in the December 2016 Coordinator's Corner about when the custom-printed Bibles will be available for purchase, their purchase price, and a photo of the new Bible.

As a reminder, the conversion of the WBS Master Series booklets to include scripture references from the English Standard Version is also well underway. In July we received 5 updated Master Series booklets (The Way to Life, God Has Spoken, This is Good News, Knowing Jesus, and Born of Water and Spirit). The last two booklets (Family of God & Live a Life of Love) have not yet been converted but should be soon. As we deplete our inventory of old NIV booklets, you will begin to see the new ESV booklets when you order materials.
